


KILLERS FOR 25 YEARS 1860-1885


The device used by postal clerks to cancel stamps changed during and following the Civil War from the use of a separate circled grid device and/or the circular date stamp (CDS) to a combined CDS/killer that supplied information as well as obliterating the stamp. Killers, not generally used until postal regulations insisted, changed from cut corks and targets to numbered or lettered metal devices indicating the clerk or the type of mail involved.

While some towns and cities became famous for special or uniquely designed killers, Washington has never been recognized as having attractive or diverse killers. This collection proves that there were quite a number of interesting and "special" markings.

The study shows the killer types (CDS killers, targets, grids, geometrics, leaves, crosses, stars, pictorials, numerals and letters) used, chronologically, at most of the existing post offices in the District of Columbia during the 1860-1885 period including Anacostia, Brightwood, Congress, Georgetown, carriers, Tennallytown and the central office.
